Working group 4 " Conceptualizing an infrastructure for collaborative research"

Following the meeting in September 2010 in Marseille, several work tracks were defined. A survey of the evaluation needs of the COST Action researchers is in progress. The purpose of the survey is to understand better the practices of the researchers and their use of digital tools, and then to estimate the adequacy of these tools to the research projects led within the framework of wide and geographically scattered networks. The nature of the research projects defined in the working groups of the COST Action must be analyzed to determine a set of good practices to agree on over time. Working group 4 is lacking visibility in comparison with the other groups. We should give a clearer identity to our role within the framework of the Action.
