III. WORK PLAN

(1) OBJECTIVES

Please describe the objectives to be achieved during the grant period and their relationship to the goals of the Action as laid down in the MoU or as modified by the Management Committee.

The objectives to be achieved during year 3 according to the general goals of the Action are:

1. the organization of a Training School in order to provide the basis of a common digital culture, adapted to the research domain, to the Action's members. The TS was initially scheduled for year 2, but was postponed to year 3 by the MC (see item 6 of the minutes of the Action's 2d MC meeting)

2. to convene the 3rd Annual Workshop intended in the MoU of the Action: *Dissonant architectural heritage in the postcolonial age (on the changing perceptions of « colonial » architecture in the last decades).*

3. to pursue the development of the electronic journal *ABE-Architecture beyond Europe* (<http://manuscrits.revues.org/index.php/abe/index>) (see item 8 of the of the Action's 2d MC meeting)

4. to support the strenghtening of the network and the interactions between members.

(2) **ACTIVITIES**

Please describe the contents of the activities listed in the budget, their relationship to each other (if any) and to the objectives stated above.

In order to achieve the objectives detailed above, the workplan forecasts to hold the following activities during year 3:

1. Training school on Architectural history research in the digital era:

The aim of the TS is to discuss the use of digital humanities in architectural research (for mapping networks or visualizing data, for instance), get the Action's members acquainted with major issues at stake in the digital world (copyright issues for images, Open Access, data sustainability) by external experts, disseminate best practices in data management and offer practical training on collaborative tools (such as Mendeley). The organization and follow-up of the Training school will be prepared by 2 WG4 meetings.

2. Annual Workshop "Dissonant architectural heritage in the postcolonial age":

The workshop will bring together members of the Action and external specialists to discuss the historiography of the field, the mechanisms of its development and changing perspectives, in relation to researchers from non-European countries interested in joining the conversation. Contributions on geographies and temporalities under-represented within the network will be encouraged.

3. Separate WGs and inter-WGs meetings, in order to prepare submissions to theme issues for the electronic journal *ABE-Architecture beyond Europe*: 3 separate WGs (within WG1, WG2, and WG3) and 2 inter-WGs (i.e. 'editorial meetings') on the topic of "Applied arts" and "Imperial architecture", are to take place throughout year 3.

4. Funding opportunities meeting:

In order to explore the opportunities for follow-ups of the Action, and the development of the network, members of its Core group plan to share input on possibilities within the last calls of FP7 and the future 2020 program.

5. STSMs:

STSMs will be used again to foster collaboration among participating institutions in the network, and collect data for publication. Submissions to *ABE-Architecture beyond Europe* will be encouraged.
